Atonement producer, Richard Eyre has teamed with novelist-screenwriter William Boyd for "Three Kings," an alternative take on the biblical tale.

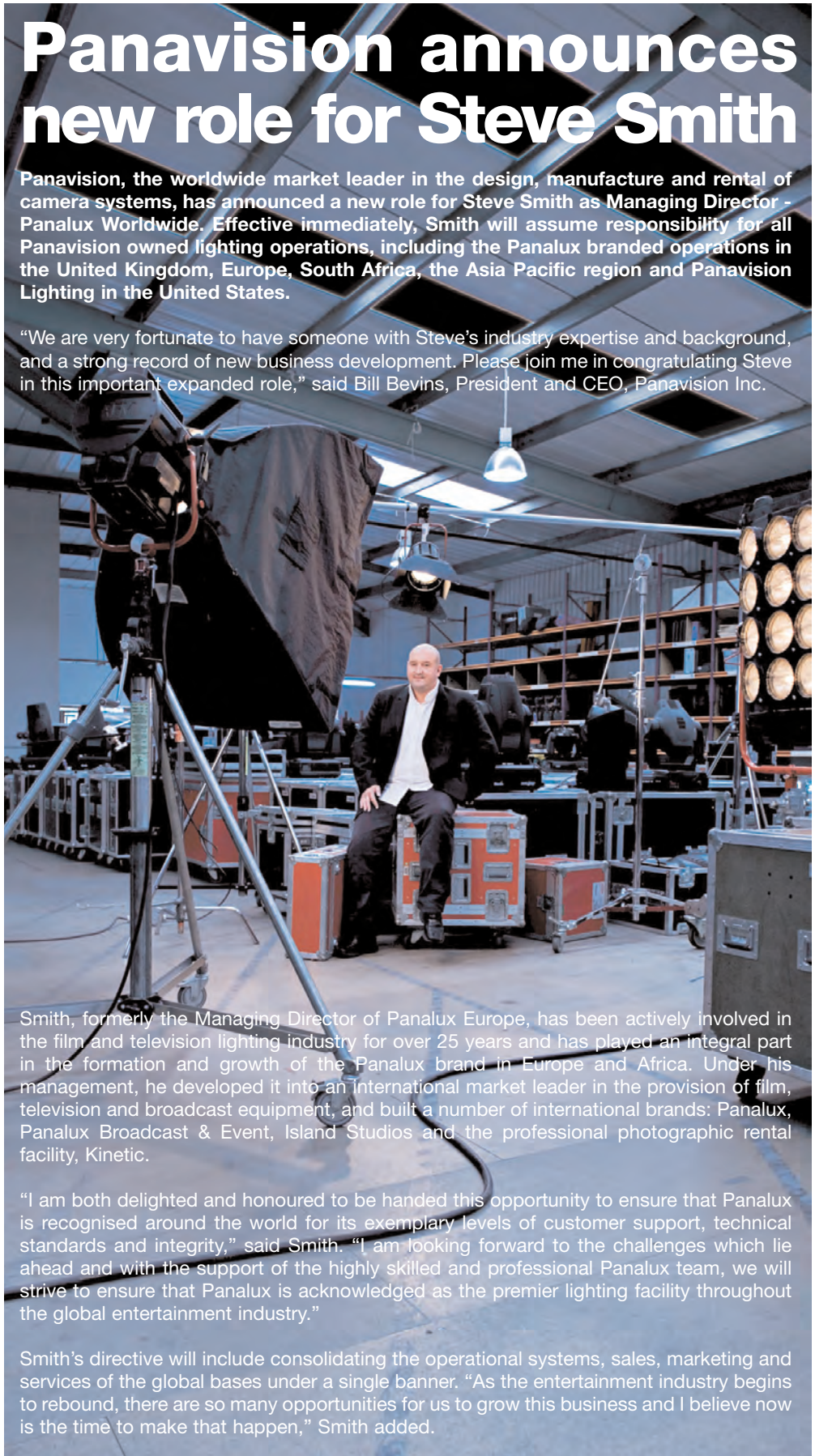

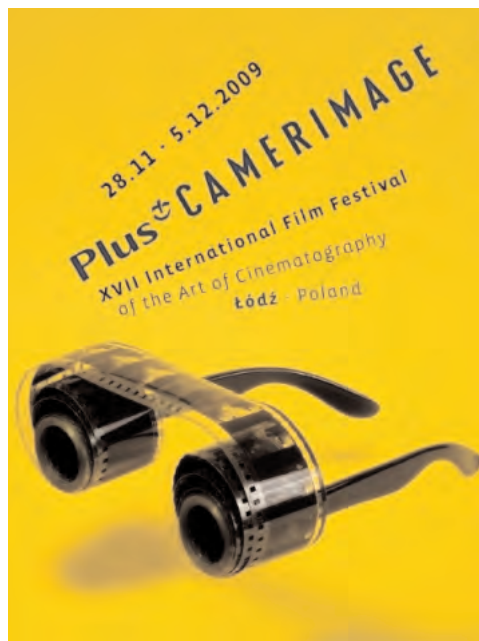
